Salem Cemetery Battlefield

Trace the footsteps of Civil War soldiers on the 120 well-preserved acres of Salem Cemetery Battlefield. The Battle of Salem Cemetery occurred on Dec. 19, 1862, just 12 days before The Battle at Parker’s Crossroads. Prior to the battle, Confederate Brig. Gen. Nathan Bedford Forrest and his Confederate brigade had been on a two-month raid to destroy railroad tracks and disrupt Union supply lines in West Tennessee. Once arriving in Jackson, they attacked a Union garrison led by Adolph Engelmann in the Old Salem Cemetery. Using the battle as a distraction, Bedford and other Confederate soldiers withdrew from the action and continued to destroy sections of the railroad to the North. They were then able to retreat into other parts of West Tennessee.
